It's time for Operation Christmas Child! Due to Covid safety restrictions and keeping our children and leaders safe, we have to do it differently this year! In years past, we have asked for donations from our church family and the children of the church have had an awesome time packing the boxes.

This year, we are issuing a challenge to all of our church family! We have 125 boxes to be packed for children across the world that, in most cases, will receive nothing for Christmas. The children of the church want each individual to pick up at least one box to fill and bring back by November 15th. Shoeboxes are available in the Sanctuary vestibule area. When picking up shoeboxes, make sure to grab one of each of the documents provided on the table with them which include information on how to pack your shoebox gift with instructions on donating the \$9 shipping cost, shoebox gift suggestions for boys or girls of different ages, and the list of prohibited items. Drop off completed boxes on the designated table in the fellowship hall. Please include your \$9 shipping fee with your box. The preferred and easiest way to give shipping cost is online (and in doing so you can discover the destination of your shoebox gift).

The Operation Christmas Child drive starts today and will end Sunday, November 15th. Please do not disappoint these kids! If all 125 are filled, it will be the most we've collected! If anyone would like to participate in packing a shoebox but is unable to get out to get a shoebox or items for it, please contact the church office as we have a volunteer who can help.

I may spend some time and share those at some point when the year is all said and done. But God can and will use even a year like 2020 for His glory. The mission carries on. Ask Him to reveal exactly what we need to learn this year about ourselves, what we need to repent of. And then apply our lives to His mission, to reach the lost for Christ, and to make disciples.
