I shared this on my social media at the end of last month. I hope it is a blessing to you as you read this today if you did not have the chance to read it before:

Years ago when I was a youth pastor, I took our students for the first time to a *Global Youth Ministry* camp. I had just got called back to Ringgold, GA at New Liberty Baptist and had the task of finding a camp that wasn't already out of space. I researched and found this ministry that was only about an hour away from us, so I was thinking that this would be a good place to go for my first year. It's local. It's cheaper. And then maybe next year, we'll go farther to a bigger camp. Well, I never did go to another camp, or at least to a camp not with that ministry. They had some camps they did off their property and we did that a couple of times. But that camp ministry was, and still is, phenomenal.

The theme of that year was *Dangerous*, based out of Exodus. One of the main driving points throughout the week was this idea of God's presence. Moses intercedes for God's people after they turn their backs on Him by making a golden calf and attributing their salvation to it and worshiping it. Moses knows that without God with them, they are nothing. He prays for His presence. That has always stuck with me, and every time I read this passage, I think of how important it is to have the presence of God with us as His people.

Without God's presence, we are no different from the world around us. Without God's presence, all we intend to do for Him is futile. Without God's presence, we do not have His favor. Without God's presence, we are lost. Ultimately, the Father sent His Son Jesus to be "God with us," and for all who believe and trust in Him, He has given us the Holy Spirit who indwells us. Yet it's still important to live by the Spirit and pray constantly, "God, go with me today. Go with us as your people." May that be our heart cry everyday as God's people, the church.
